#### **Community Major Grant** Storywalk via The Brookfield Library

The Brookfield Education Foundation was able to fund a request for ongoing storywalk programming. Championed by Debbie Brooks, Head of Children's Services at The Brookfield Library, this reusable Storywalk will be available to the entire community for years to come. This project takes literacy outdoors. Using sturdy outdoor re-fillable frames, picture books (or poetry) can be posted on each frame, and families can walk along as they read each page or part of the story, combining nature with literacy. The frames are portable and can be used in various places throughout Brookfield such as the Library, any of the school grounds, the Still River Greenway, the municipal campus, etc. Residents of all ages will benefit from this literacy focused grant.



**School Major Grant 3D PPE Printing at Brookfield High School** 

This grant was championed by 17 year veteran BHS educator Heather Biancheri. The BEF provided a 3D printer and associated equipment to make PPE for healthcare workers and first responders during the Covid crisis; video tutorials for the equipment are then to be produced and kept in an online resource as a remote teaching tool for students at BHS. Finally, products created using the printer will be the 'jumping off' point for a new club at BHS which will encourage relevant volunteerism and empathy in students.





### **Community Major Grant** Blood Pressure Self-Monitoring at the YMCA

Championed by Lisa O'Connor of the YMCA, the BEF has funded a Blood Pressure Self-Monitoring Program which will be delivered to participants virtually. The Y developed this program to help individuals better manage hypertension, improve their overall health and offer regular blood pressure checks. The program includes virtual office consultations for one on one support, Nutrition Education Seminars, and the opportunity for problem solving and social interaction among participants. The program is offered to ten Brookfield residents who will receive blood pressure cuffs at the beginning of this pilot program which began in September 2020.
